Miramar Community Shuttle Red Route Service

The City of Miramar and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the Miramar Red Community Shuttle Route. This free service will increase the number of destinations and connections through public transit.

Connections are available to BCT routes 2, 5, 7, 16, 23, 28, 95-Express, University Breeze, Miramar Green, Miramar Orange, and Miramar Yellow Community Shuttle Routes.

All shuttles are air-conditioned & wheelchair accessible. Bicycle racks are also provided. Riders making connections to other BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fares.

Hours of Operation See Schedule

The shuttle will operate as close to schedule as possible. Traffic conditions or inclement weather may cause the shuttle to arrive earlier or later than the expected time.

The Miramar Red Community Shuttle Route will not operate once a hurricane warning has been issued or if other hazards do not allow for the safe operation of the shuttle.

Holidays

The Miramar Red Community Shuttle Route does not operate on weekends or the following holidays.

New Year's Day • Memorial Day Juneteenth

Independence Day • Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day • Christmas Day

Bike Racks

Bike racks are available on Miramar Community Shuttles. Racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the Shuttle approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

Loading

- Always load your bike from the curbside of the street.
- Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the shuttle.
- Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

Unloading

- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- Move quickly to the curb.
