Housing Trust Fund Generates New Units

The Broward County Affordable Housing Trust Fund (AHTF) was established on November 7, 2017, by Section 11.09 of the Broward County Charter to increase the construction and/or preservation of affordable housing units countywide. The purpose of the AHTF is to provide a continuing, non-lapsing fund for the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) to use to address the need for affordable housing in Broward County Since 2018, the BOCC has awarded approximately \$21.3M to seven (7) projects (as shown below) totaling approximately 770 affordable multifamily units. The program is designed to serve the very-low, low and moderate-income families, while creating and sustaining affordable housing throughout Broward County.
