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

INTERESTED IN EARNING MORE CONTACT HOURS?

- 28 hours of training are required during the 2-year building certification cycle.
- 60 hours of training are required during the 4-year fire certification cycle.
- By attending Broward BORA's board meetings and/or committee meetings, 1 hour of the required credit will be earned.
- By attending professional association meetings approved by the BORA Staff (i.e. FAPGMI, IAEI, COEA), ½ hour of the required credit will be earned for each meeting attended.

A maximum of 14 total contact hours through board and/or committee meetings can be earned per certification cycle.

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2024-2025 BORA RECERTIFICATION CYCLE

The 2024-2025 Building Recertification Cycle ends on Tuesday, December 5, 2023. Be sure to submit your recertification packet to the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals office (1 N. University Drive, Suite 3500B, Plantation, FL 33324) prior to the deadline.

<u>Recertification Forms</u> can be found on the Broward BORA website. All Building Officials, Assistant Building Officials, Chief Inspectors, Plans Examiners, and Inspectors who are presently certified by BORA must complete this process.

IMPORTANT! Please ensure the following when submitting your recertification:

- Complete and return all forms to the Board of Rules and Appeals office by December 5, 2023.
- Attach the Continuing Education Affidavit signed by the applicant.
- 28 educational contact hours must have been completed by December.

 Note: At least ½ of this requirement must be discipline-specific courses.
- Please include the notarized Affidavit, Board of Rules and Appeals Policy #14-02.
- Your new 2024-2025 recertification cards will be valid through December 31, 2025.

BUILDING SAFETY INSPECTION PROGRAM FOLLOW UP

Municipal Building Departments throughout Broward County sent notifications to property owners whose buildings are subject to the <u>Building Safety Inspection Program</u>, beginning the process of having the property inspection completed by a Florida-licensed professional.

Please be advised that the Building Safety Inspection Program does not require the building to be brought up to the current code.

If you do not receive a notification and your property is 25 years or older, don't hesitate to contact the building department in the municipality where your property is located. You will still be held accountable for completing the inspection whether the municipality contacts you or not. For structural questions, contact <u>Jack Morell</u> or <u>Michael Guerasio</u>. For electrical questions, contact <u>Kenneth Castronovo</u>. For previous inspection records, please contact the <u>Municipality</u> where your property is located.

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AMENDMENTS FOR THE 8TH EDITION OF THE FLORIDA BUILDING CODE (FBC)

- BORA Formal Interpretations Readopted for the 8th Edition of the Florida Building Code (FBC) The Board readopted BORA Formal Interpretations (FI) for the 8th Edition of the Florida Building Code (FBC). The Broward BORA staff reviewed and revised the formal interpretations to adhere to the updated code. The 7th Edition FI-18 and FI-26 were not renewed. The Formal Interpretations will go into effect on December 31, 2023.
- Technical Amendments to the 8th Edition of the Florida Building Code (FBC) At a public hearing in November, the Board approved the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals Technical Amendments to the 8th Edition of the Florida Building Code (FBC). The Technical Amendments will go into effect on December 31, 2023.








2024 BORA BOARD MEETING CALENDAR

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2023 BORA ENERGY GUIDELINES (8TH EDITION)

After receiving recommendations from the <u>BORA Energy Conservation Committee</u>, the Board <u>Approved</u> the updated BORA Energy Guidelines.

- 2023 BORA Commercial Energy Guidelines, Eighth Edition
- 2023 BORA Residential Energy Guidelines, Eighth Edition

The updated guidelines include the Amendments to the (2023) Florida Building Code, Energy Conservation. These guidelines are a helpful tool for Building Officials to adopt as part of their plan review and inspection processes, as an aid to assign duties and ensure compliance.

The Florida Building Code Energy Conservation Administrative Chapters do not designate which discipline-specific code official will review energy compliance reports, building plans, or inspect specific items.

2024 BROWARD COUNTY FIRE INSPECTOR EXAM REGISTRATION

The <u>2024 Exam Dates</u> are available for the Broward County Fire Inspector Exam. To qualify for the exam, submit the completed, signed <u>Application</u> and policy statement by mail to the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals or email to <u>Jonda Joseph</u>.

The Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals will pay for first-time test takers to take the Broward County Fire Inspector Exam. A \$60.00 fee will be required to retake the exam by the test taker.

Broward BORA will, upon request, provide auxiliary aids and services leading to effective communication for people with disabilities, including qualified sign language interpreters, assistive listening devices, documents in Braille, and other ways of making communications accessible to people with speech, hearing, or vision impairments.

Please be sure to request auxiliary aids or services on the exam application.

Broward County Code of Ordinances, ARTICLE IX. BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION, Section 9.02

"Building Code and the Board of Rules and Appeals" mandates that BORA members shall be appointed as follows:

- Seven (7) members and six (6) alternates shall be appointed by the Broward County League of Cities.
- Six (6) members and three (3) alternates shall be appointed by the County Commission.
