Managing the BMSD



Grant and job training programs, small business development, and other resources available (Office of Economic and Small Business Development).



The Residential Rental Registration and Inspection Program addresses rental properties maintenance issues and other County programs continue to promote new construction and residential rehabilitation (Code Enforcement).



Inspections and Hazardous Material Facility Licensing protect the County's wellfields and water resources (Environmental and Consumer Protection).



Investing in Our Community



New Pocket Park at SW 50th Avenue – exercise path, fencing, children's play area, landscaping and irrigation system (Parks and Recreation).



Financial assistance available for minor home repairs and exterior painting (Housing Finance and Community Redevelopment).



County water and sewer lines have been installed and grants are available to residents to connect to the system (Water and Wastewater Services).



Fire Station 23 has been renovated to include modern amenities (BSO – Fire Rescue).



Building Healthy & Vibrant Places



A new Sunview Park community center coming soon with offices, computer room, assembly hall, and playground; the park's entrance signs were enhanced with landscaping (Parks and Recreation).



County installed new wayfinding signs in the neighborhood (Planning and Development Management and Traffic Engineering).



Bulk pickup schedules are available in print and online in English and Spanish (Solid Waste and Recycling).



Enhancing a Safe Community



Code Enforcement inspects more than 1,500 properties annually to address code violations.



BSO has three new enforcement initiatives that focus on auto-theft investigations, anti-drug, and anti-dumping.



Plans are underway to install surveillance cameras along public streets and highways in Broadview Park to assist law enforcement, and new neighborhood entrance signs with solar lights have been installed (BSO).
