Managing the BMSD



Flood Insurance Coverage Improvement Plan assists residents to receive up to 15 percent discount on flood insurance premiums (Environmental Engineering & Permitting).



Grant and job training programs, small business development, and other resources available from the Office of Economic and Small Business Development.



Community partnerships offer wage assistance for small businesses to hire new employees and increase capacity (Broward Municipal Services District).



Destination Sistrunk promotes cultural tourism through historic landmarks, trolley/walking tours, wayfinding signs, and an interactive website (Cultural Division).



Investing in Our Community



Drainage improvements in Washington Park alleviate flooding along NW 9th Street (Highway & Bridge Maintenance).



Financial assistance available for minor home repairs and exterior painting (Housing Finance & Community Redevelopment).



'Closing the Digital Divide in the BMSD' Pilot Program offers income eligible households free data and tablets for online access to education, employment and family resources (Libraries, Enterprise Technology Services, Planning & Development Management).



Promoting Safe Streets



Enhanced traffic signal boxes with artwork from local artists that compliments the neighborhoods (Cultural Division, Traffic Engineering).



Sistrunk & NW 27th Avenue improvements completed: resurfacing, pedestrian lighting, landscaped medians, decorative crosswalks, bike lanes, street signage, and curb ramps for wheelchair/scooter access (Highway Construction & Engineering).



Traffic studies performed and speed humps installed in response to residents requests (Traffic Engineering).



Building Healthy & Vibrant Places



Neighborhood entryways enhanced with new landscaping and signage (Highway & Bridge Maintenance, Parks & Recreation).



The County is partnering with nonprofits to build 40 new affordable homes. Down payment and closing assistance available. 18 single family homes built in Franklin Park Estates (Housing Finance and Community Redevelopment).



Improvements at neighborhood parks include: covered playgrounds, an outdoor fitness center at Delevoe Park, a new community center and outdoor amenities at Lafayette Hart Park (Highway Construction and Engineering and Parks & Recreation)



Enhancing a Safe Community



Upgrades along 27th Avenue to include new LED streetlights and other infrastructure improvements (Public Works, Traffic Engineering).



More BSO deputies assigned to the area for public nuisance and crime reduction team. Plans are underway to install surveillance cameras along public streets to assist law enforcement.



Safe Routes Broward mobile app allows quick and easy reporting of non-emergency municipal service issues (Planning & Development Management).



The Residential Rental Registration and Inspection Program addresses rental properties maintenance issues (Code Enforcement).
