- Service Area:** 410 square miles within Broward County. BCT buses connect to Palm Beach and Miami-Dade transit systems and to Tri-Rail.
- Total Active Fleet:** 291 fixed route buses  
78 community buses

- Routes:** 40 on Weekdays, 37 on Saturdays, 35 on Sundays

- Hours of Operation:** Some as early as 4:45 a.m. until 12:25 a.m.
- Fares:** Regular: \$1.25\*  
Senior/Youth/Disabled/Medicare: 60¢\*  
Children under 40" Free
- Bus Pass:** A cost-savings pass for daily, unlimited travel for a specific period of time. Available is an All-Day pass (\$3), 7-Day pass (\$12), 10-Ride pass (\$11.50) and a 31-Day pass (\$46). Discounted price available for seniors, youth, disabled, college students and medicare eligibles.
