RESOLUTION NO. 2024-273

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR A REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, THE DATE OF THE GENERAL ELECTION, TO DETERMINE WHETHER TO AMEND THE BROWARD COUNTY CHARTER ("CHARTER") TO REMOVE ALL MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES FOR THE BROWARD COUNTY HOUSING COUNCIL ("COUNCIL") THAT ARE PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 11.06 OF THE CHARTER, INCLUDE A PROVISION ALLOWING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO ESTABLISH MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES OF THE COUNCIL BY ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDE THAT THE COUNCIL BE COMPOSED OF AT LEAST SEVENTEEN (17) VOTING MEMBERS AND NO MORE THAN NINETEEN (19) TOTAL MEMBERS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Section 11.06 of the Broward County Charter ("Charter") creates the Broward County Housing Council ("Council") and prescribes the membership categories of the Council:

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Charter refer to entities no longer in existence or require a level of specificity in membership composition that has resulted in extended vacancies on the Council;

WHEREAS, certain membership categories prescribed in Section 11.06 of the

WHEREAS, the Council has requested the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), amend the Charter to remove all membership categories for the Council that are prescribed in Section 11.06 of the Charter, provide that the Board shall establish the membership categories of the Council by ordinance to allow greater flexibility for membership categories on the Council, and provide that the total membership of the Council be composed of at least seventeen (17) voting members and no more than nineteen (19) total members; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the public interest will be served by amending the Charter as requested by the Council, subject to voter approval, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Subject to an affirmative vote of the general electorate, Section 11.06 of the Charter of Broward County, Florida, entitled "Broward County Housing Council," is hereby amended to read as follows (with the remaining paragraphs being relettered as necessary):

Sec. 11.06. Broward County Housing Council.

- A. There shall be a Broward County Housing Council that shall serve in an advisory capacity to the County Commission and facilitate coordination between the County, Municipalities, the business community, and not-for-profit groups to address housing issues including, but not limited to, affordable housing, workforce housing, and homelessness.
- B. Membership. The Broward County Housing Council shall be comprised composed of at least seventeen (17) voting members and no more than

C. The Broward County Commission, at its discretion, may appoint additional members to the Broward County Housing Council, provided that the Council shall be comprised of no more than nineteen (19) members with an odd number of voting members.

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Section 2. A referendum election is called for the General Election on November 5, 2024, and at such other times as permitted for voting under Chapter 101, Florida Statutes, to determine whether to amend Section 11.06 of the Broward County Charter relating to the membership of the Council.

Section 3. Upon voter approval of the amendment to the Charter as provided herein, and enactment of the ordinance that establishes membership categories for the Council, all sitting members of the Council shall continue to serve their term pursuant to Section 11.06 of the Broward County Charter provided they continue to meet the qualifications for appointment as stated in the subject ordinance.

Section 4. In accordance with Section 100.342, Florida Statutes, at least thirty (30) days' notice of the referendum election shall be published by the Broward County Administrator in a newspaper of general circulation in Broward County. The publication shall be made at least twice, including once in the fifth week and once in the third week prior to the week in which the referendum is to be held. The notice is hereby attached as Exhibit A and made a part hereof. Notice can also be made in accordance with Section 50.0311, Florida Statutes, either in addition to or in lieu of notice in accordance with Section 100.342, Florida Statutes.

Section 5. Said referendum election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 5, 2024, and at such other days and times as provided under applicable law, including for early voting as provided by Section 101.657, Florida Statutes, at the polling places established in Broward County. All registered and qualified electors in Broward County shall be eligible to vote in the referendum election. Vote-by-mail ballots and early voting access for the referendum shall be made available as provided by law.

Section 6. The election boards consisting of the clerks and inspectors appointed to serve for the November 5, 2024, General Election are hereby appointed to serve in the referendum election in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. The Broward County Canvassing Board shall canvass the returns in said election and shall certify the results of the referendum election as provided by law.

Section 8. The County Administrator shall furnish a certified copy of this adopted Resolution to the Supervisor of Elections for Broward County promptly upon adoption by the Board.

Section 9. The title and summary of the referendum question to appear on the November 5, 2024, General Election, as embodied in this enabling Resolution, shall be as follows:

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024, TO DETERMINE WHETHER TO AMEND THE BROWARD COUNTY CHARTER RELATING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BROWARD COUNTY HOUSING COUNCIL.

A countywide referendum election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, and at such other times as provided for by Chapter 101, Florida Statutes, for the purpose of determining whether to amend the Broward County Charter relating to the membership of the Broward County Housing Council.

As set forth in enabling Resolution No. 2024-273, adopted on May 21, 2024, by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, the title and summary to appear on the referendum ballot shall be as follows:

The referendum shall be held on November 5, 2024, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and at such other days and times as provided under applicable law, including for early voting as provided by Section 101.657, Florida Statutes, at the polling places established in Broward County. All registered and qualified electors of Broward County shall be eligible to vote in said referendum election. Vote-by-mail ballots for the referendum election shall be prepared and made available as provided by law.

The Broward County Canvassing Board shall canvass the returns and certify the results of the referendum election to the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, the Broward County Administrator, and the Florida Department of State, to be recorded and filed in appropriate public records.
