F-104.1.4 Have been fulfilling the duties of a Fire Marshal/Fire Code Official with five (5) years continuous service as such within a county or city in the State of Florida and shall possess a Broward County Certification. F-104.1.5 Possesses a certification issued by the State Fire Marshal as a Fire Code Manager/Administrator in accordance with NFPA 1030 with a total of six (6) years experience with a county or city as fire plans examiner and inspector in Florida and shall possess a Broward County Certification.					
	F-104.1.6 Three (3) years of experience as a Broward County Certified Plans Examiner and nationally certified as an NFP Certified Fire Inspector 1 (CFI-1), NFPA Certified Fire Plans Examiner (CFPE), and NFPA Certified Fire Protection Specialist (CFPS).
