SUBJECT: **2023-24 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES**

On January 9, 2025, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 Florida school districts. State and district data are located online at the FLDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

According to the 2023-24 High School Graduation Rate FLDOE press release "Today, Governor Ron DeSantis announced that Florida's high school graduation rate rose to 89.7 percent during the 2023-2024 school year, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over last year, exceeding the pre-pandemic rate of 86.9% for the 2018-2019 school year."

Graduation rates in this memorandum compare the 2023-24 academic year to 2022-23. Key highlights from this data include:

- Florida's Federal graduation rate is 89.7% in 2023-24, which is an increase of 1.7 percentage points from 88.0% in 2022-23.
- Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) Federal Graduation Rate is 89.0% which represents a 0.3 percentage points increase from the 2022-23 (88.7%).
- Five District high schools increased graduations rates by 3 or more percentage points in 2023-24 compared to 2022-23:
 - **Boyd Anderson High School** (5.1 percentage points),
 - **Charles Flanagan High School** (3.7 percentage points),
 - **Coral Springs High School** (3 percentage points),
 - **Hollywood Hills High School** (3 percentage points)
 - **South Plantation High School** (3.1 percentage points).

- 34 of 36 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher and 24 of these schools reached a graduation rate at or above 95%.
- Seven District high schools earned 100% graduation rates: **Atlantic Technical High School, Broward Virtual Franchise, College Academy at Broward College, Lauderhill 6-12, McFatter Technical College, Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy,** and **Pompano Beach High School.**
- **College Academy at Broward College** achieved a graduation rate of 100% for the thirteenth consecutive year.
- The 2023-24 graduation rate for Black students, Hispanic students, American Indian or Alaska Native students, Two or More Races students and White students in Broward exceeds the state.

Subsequent pages provide further detail and analysis including comparison of graduation rates for Florida’s five largest districts and graduation rates by school.

Table 1 displays the historical graduation rates for Florida’s five largest districts and the State overall. In 2023-24, Broward had a graduation rate of 89.0.

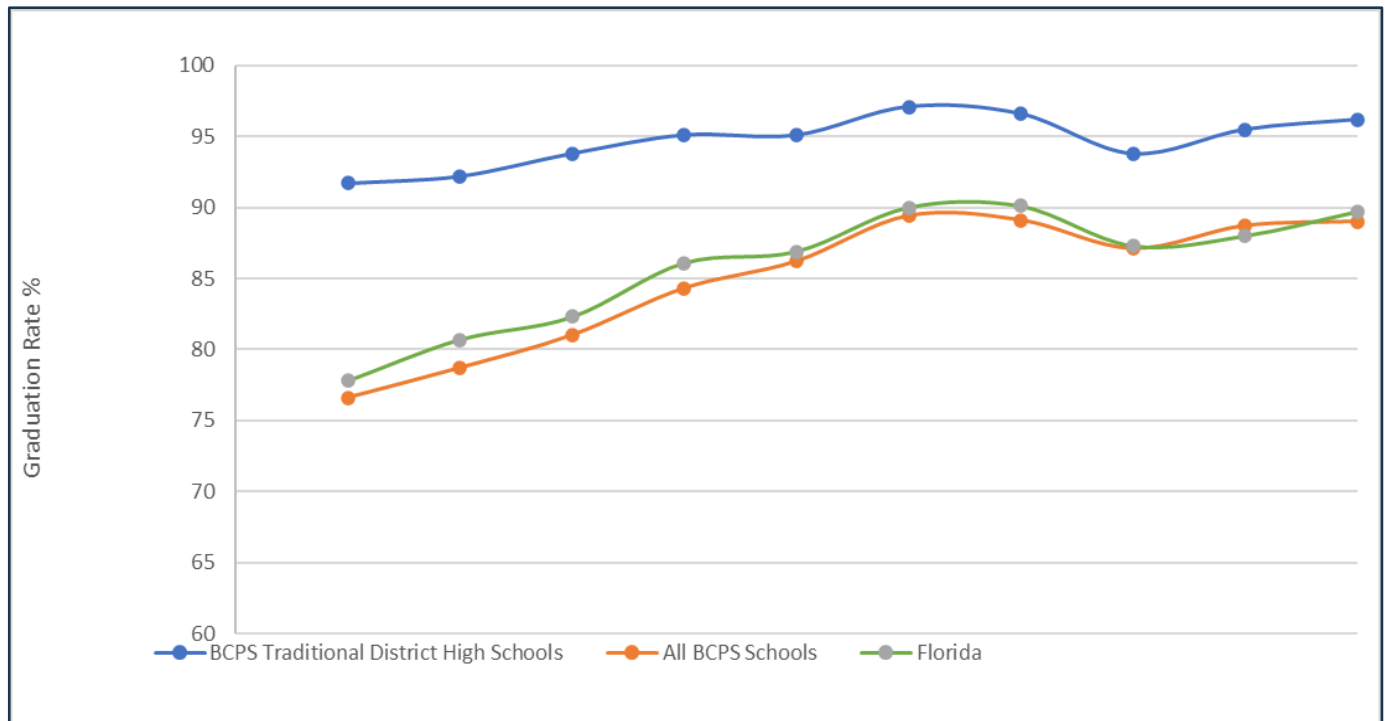
Table 1A shows the 2023-24 graduation rates for Florida’s five largest districts and the State by subgroup. The 2023-24 graduation rate for:

- Black students, Hispanic students, and White students in Broward exceeds the state.
- The 2023-24 graduation rate for Students with Disabilities (SWD) in Broward matched the state.

Figure 1 illustrates the ten-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional District high schools, BCPS overall (including high schools, centers and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional District high schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 96.2% in 2023-24.

Table 2 shows the graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS. The graduation rates increased for Black, Hispanic, and White students. In 2023-24, the gap between Black and White students increased by 0.2 percentage points and the gap between Hispanic and White students decreased by 0.7 percentage points compared to 2022-23.

Table 3 shows the graduation rates by subgroups served in BCPS.

- English Language Learners (ELL) showed the largest increase in graduation rate up 2.1 percentage points from 2022-23.
- Students with Disabilities (SWD) showed a 1.6 percentage points decrease in graduation rate compared to 2022-23.
- Free and Reduced-Price Lunch (FRL) students showed a 0.4 percentage point increase in graduation rate compared to 2022-23. The graduation rate gap between FRL and Non-FRL students decreased by 0.6 percentage points compared to 2022-23.
- The gap for SWD and Non-SWD students increased by 2.3 percentage points.
- The graduation rate gap between ELL and Non-ELL students decreased by 1.9 percentage points to 11.0.
