TREE PRESERVATION TRUST FUND COMMITTEE

Thursday February 20th, 2025, 2:00 PM Hybrid Meeting via Teams

A meeting of the Tree Preservation Trust Fund Committee (TPTFC) was held on Thursday February 20th, 2024, commencing at 2:00pm in person at 1 North University Drive, Sabal Palm Room and virtually on Teams (The TPTFC meeting minutes were summarized by Peter Burke (pburke@broward.org or 954-519-1224).

- 1. Statement of Meeting Objectives: The meeting was held to review two applications for funding.
- 2. Roll Call: Peter Burke of the Environmental Permitting Division attended in person. Committee Members Ron Rollins, Highway Construction and Engineering Division and Mike Orfanedes, UF/ IFAS representing the Parks and Recreation Division attended virtually.
- 3. Public Comments: None.
- 4. The Minutes of the 12/17/24 meeting was approved.
- 5. New Business:
 - a. An application for funding for an aerial lift was reviewed. The application was submitted by the Broward County Parks and Recreation Division. The request was for \$146,710.00 for the purchase of an Aerial Lift and Trailer to be used for the maintenance of trees in Broward County Parks. After a short discussion the application was approved for funding in the amount of \$146,710.00 with Peter Burke and Ron Rollins voting for approval. Mike Orfanedes abstained from voting as his agency works closely with the Parks and Recreation Division.
 - b. An application for funding for a tree giveaway to be held Earth Day, April 22nd, 2025. The application was submitted by the City of Miramar. The request was for \$5,000.00 in matching funds for a tree giveaway with an overall cost of \$11,610.00. for the purchase of 300 trees for the tree giveaway. After a discussion the application was approved for funding by a unanimous vote of the TPTFC. The approval was subject to the following conditions.
 - 1. Pond Apple, Avocado and Seagrape should be removed from the tree giveaway list and Simpson, Spanish or Red Stopper should be added.
 - 2. The size of the trees to be given away should be changed from 15 and 7 gallon to 3 gallon.
 - 3. The tree giveaway should have an educational component.
 - 4. The number of trees to be given away should be increased to make up for the reduction in size.
