Continuum of Care Program Request for Renewal Letters of Interest**

Broward County Board of County Commissioners announces a Request for Renewal Letters of Interest (RLOI) in response to the **U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) FY 2025 Continuum of Care Program (CoC) Competition and Youth Homeless Demonstration Program (YHDP) Grants Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)** for the provision of homeless assistance programs in Broward County.

ALL AGENCIES WITH EXISTING HUD COC - FUNDED PROJECTS THAT ARE EXPIRING IN FISCAL YEAR 2026 MUST SUBMIT A RLOI TO RENEW ITS PROJECT(S) FOR THE 2025 HUD COC AWARD YEAR. Renewal projects include Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH), Rapid Re-Housing (RRH), Transitional Housing (TH), Supportive Services Only (SSO), and Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). Agencies must submit this letter to Broward County to be considered for inclusion in Broward County's Collaborative Application.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS: Only agencies with an existing HUD CoC agreement under 24 CFR Part 578 are eligible to submit a RLOI. RLOIs are limited to two pages, must be submitted on the agency's letterhead stationery, and include all the following bullet points for consideration in the next stage of the County's Collaborative Application process. Agencies must submit a RLOI for each eligible project.

- Applicant agency legal name.
- Name of contact person (who will be coordinating project application).
- Contact's telephone number and e-mail address.
- Eligible HUD CoC project (i.e. PSH, RRH, TH, SSO, HMIS).
- Brief description of the eligible project and any additional proposed eligible components and information, if applicable.
- Requests for expansion of renewal project, if applicable. Include the requested increased amount, a description of the expansion, and justification for the expansion.

RLOIs, as outlined in this notice, must be received at HSDProposals@broward.org no later than **Tuesday, November 25, 2025, at 5:00 P.M.**

Late submission of RLOIs is a fatal flaw, and late RLOIs will not be considered as a HUD CoC Renewal project. Failure to receive notification from staff is not subject to appeal.

Broward County will announce next steps in the HUD CoC Collaborative Application process once more information is released by HUD.
