

Questions from Renewal Workshop and the Responses

1. What is a “conditionally” selected grant’?

If a new project application passes the project eligibility threshold review in section III.C.4.a. and receives enough points to pass the project quality threshold review in section III.C.4.a. of this NOFO but does not receive all the points available for its project type, HUD may place conditions on the grant award that must be satisfied before HUD will execute a grant agreement with the applicant for the project. If an applicant is unable to satisfy the condition(s) within the timeframe specified by HUD, HUD reserves the right to withdraw the conditionally awarded funds.

2. Are all renewal applicants eligible to apply for this?

HUD will make this adjustment; you do not apply for these increases. Explanation below.

“Cost of Living Adjustments for Conditionally Selected Grants”. The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024 authorizes HUD to make reasonable cost of living adjustments to renewal amounts to help afford increasing cost of operations due to inflation. See section V.D below. (*Page 111 of the FY 2024 and FY 2025 Continuum of Care Competition Renewal and Replacement of Youth Homeless Demonstration Program Grants*).

3. Where may Providers locate a complete list of required attachments?

On page 21 of the Renewal Detailed Instructions, you will find directions for attachments. In E-SNAPS this is Screen 7A. Attachments. The Certificate of Consolidation will be provided to you by the County Staff to upload as well.

4. Will Broward County provide the signed Certification of Consistency with the Consolidate Plan forms to Providers for uploading with each application in E-Snaps?

As noted during the Renewal Workshop on August 15, 2024, the Certificate of Consistency with the Consolidated Plan will be provided to all renewal projects with the exception of Chalet Apartments which is obtaining their own due to jurisdictional issues.
