BUILDING CODE DIVISION

Before starting any project, consult with Building Code Division staff to determine if a permit is reguired. Some small or simple projects may not need a permit, but it's crucial to confirm this with staff to avoid penalties. As a homeowner, you may be eligible to apply for a permit if you are a permanent resident, though major projects typically require a licensed contractor. Permit costs are minimal compared to potential penalties. During hurricane season, it's recommended to check the condition of your roof, windows and small structures on your property to prevent hazards. Code Enforcement is a regulatory agency tasked with ensuring compliance with the Florida Building Code. Our office is ready to assist you and work directly with you, prior to commencing the work. As you navigate through the Building Code Division's website, here's a glossary of some common terms you may come across.

CODE COMPLIANCE

In May 2024, the Code Compliance Section moved to the Building Code Division to enhance enforcement, inspection and permitting services in the Broward Municipal Services District (BMSD). This restructuring aims to improve regulatory compliance through closer collaboration with other County departments and neighborhood associations.

Code Compliance Inspectors actively investigate issues like construction without permits, property maintenance, overgrown vegetation and illegal dumping to maintain quality of life in the BMSD. Residents are encouraged to report potential code violations through the MyBroward App, by calling 311 or by emailing codecomplaint@broward.org. Reports should include the resident's name and address for investigation. If a violation is confirmed, the responsible party will be notified and given time to address the issue, with potential fines or other actions if non-compliance continues. Code Compliance BMSD.

BMSD ZONING REMINDERS

Landlord registration for residential rental units is required by the Broward County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 39, Article 39-118. Any property owner wishing to rent one and up to four units is required to obtain a Residential Rental Certificate. Applications for Residential Rental Certificates are readily available online and must be mailed or dropped off, with an annual \$75.00 fee.
