



Acknowledgment of COVID-19 Guidelines for Facility Rentals

Safe Rentals at Parks

Broward County Parks and Recreation Division (“County”) is happy to welcome you back into our parks for your rental, but we have some new requirements and expectations at this time to keep you, other park patrons, and our staff safe.

The undersigned representative acknowledges and understands that Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) was declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization and that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) has stated that “the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus.” Additional information on the CDC guidelines related to COVID-19 may be found at: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html>.

Some of the important points for you and your party to understand are:

- Facial coverings/masks must always be worn by all persons, except when actively eating or drinking, unless social distancing of six feet can be maintained at all times from people who do not live in the same household.
- Rental capacity is limited to a maximum of 50 percent, not to exceed 100 persons, although some facilities are lower. Please double-check your rental agreement for the maximum attendance you may have.
- Playgrounds and fitness zones remain closed.
- Guests that are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have been potentially exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms should remain home and not join your event hosted at parks.
- Guests shall not serve themselves from “buffet-style” lines. There should be a dedicated person, wearing mask and gloves, responsible for serving guests food and desserts.
- Hand sanitizer should be made available for all guests.
- Guests shall have pre-assigned tables.
- Registered Vendors may be hired, but their representatives must be factored into the capacity limit. In addition, certain vendors are not permitted at this time.
