

Total Approved/County Adopted Budget FY2019 to FY2025






Zip Codes with lowest level of Household Income, American Community Survey, 2022

39% of surtax investments are expected to occur in Broward County zip codes with lowest household incomes (per American Community Survey, 2022)


Notes:

- "Investments" = surtax funding budgeted and appropriated for projects and community shuttle contracts through FY2025. Investments do not include transit transfers to operating (transit services); funding not associated with a specific project; projects that cannot be geographically mapped (countywide studies, planning, designs, etc.); support services and certain contractual services
- When a project overlaps zip codes total funding is included for each impacted zip code (duplication).





Value of surtax investments, NW quadrant; does not include non-surtax funding sources







Estimated Value of Municipal Capital Projects, Rehab. and Maintenance Projects, and Community Shuttle Program








Municipal Projects: Estimated Cost Savings FY2020 – FY 2025






What is Coming for FY2026 – FY2029?


County Projects – County Adopted Budget





Municipal Program – County Adopted Budget





Surtax Performance Auditing-A Discussion

What is a Performance Audit?

- Objective analysis to assist management and those charged with governance and oversight to:
 - improve program performance and operations and/or reduce costs
 - facilitate decision making by parties with responsibility to oversee or initiate corrective action
 - contribute to public accountability
- Performance audit objectives can vary and may include assessments of:
 - program effectiveness, economy, and efficiency
 - internal control
 - compliance
 - current status or prospective analyses
- May include aspects of 'compliance'
 - evaluating program effectiveness may also involve an additional objective of evaluating the program's internal controls.

Performance Audit of Program vs Project

Performance Audit can consider:

- Success of an <u>overall</u> program in achieving its goals (macro level)
 - Consideration of program in its totality, can include multiple aspects of operations, projects objectives
 - Higher level examination of the complete entity/service
- Success of a specific aspect of a program
 - ▶ A focused approach of one component of the overall program
- Success of a specific project (micro level)
 - Review of a single project

Our Recommendation:

- First Five Years of Surtax Program Implementation
 - Is program delivered in a manner consistent with ballot initiatives?
 - ► Look at 30-year plan
 - ▶ What has been spent, where?
- Possible Analyses of dollars expended:
 - ▶ By Ballot Focus Areas:
 - ► traffic congestion, roads and bridges, traffic signal synchronization, safe sidewalks and bicycle pathways, bus and special needs transportation, rail, and emerging transportation technologies
 - ▶ By Project: locations, type, completed/in progress
 - ▶ By Nature: Operating, tangible assets, roadway, reserves, administration


Initial Performance Audit Suggestion:

- Benefits:
 - ► 'Pulse point' of Surtax after first five years
 - ▶ Offer a general perspective on program status
 - ► Can be first of re-occurring five-year performance audit
 - Create framework/baseline analyses that can be compared over time
 - ▶ May help identify focus areas for a more in-depth review
 - ▶ Use findings to determine subject matter for future audits
 - Potential identification of specific aspect of program, operational area, or project for 'deeper dive'
- Can be completed by our Office
 - Quicker start than initiating a procurement process


