Recommended approval per the Planning Council staff's recommendation, recognizing the applicant's voluntary commitment to restrict at least 15% of the additional proposed dwelling units for affordable housing at the "moderate-income" level or below for a minimum of 30 years, or requiring an in lieu-payment per unit to satisfy said set aside. In addition, if the amendment is adopted by the County Commission, this action by the Planning Council shall be considered the "conditional" recertification of the municipal land use plan.
