PH 1 RECERTIFICATION PCR 24-5

Public Hearing on Recertification of the City of Oakland Park Future Land Use Element – Text Amendment – Provisionally recertified the City's Future Land Use Element per Planning Council staff recommendation.

PH 2 REDEVELOPMENT UNIT ALLOCATION REQUEST PCRU 24-2

Public Hearing on Redevelopment Unit Allocation Request – City of Wilton Manors– Recommended approval per Planning Council staff recommendation of the allocation of 750 Redevelopment Units to the City of Wilton Manors, including at least 75 units deed restricted to low - or very low-income individuals for a period of 30 years per City Resolution 2024-076. This item will be scheduled for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners.

PH 3 AMENDMENT PC 24-7

Public Hearing on Small-Scale Amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan - City of Hollywood — Recommended approval per Planning Council staff recommendation, recognizing the applicant's voluntary commitment to restrict 15% of the dwelling units as affordable housing at the "moderate-income" level or below for a minimum of 30 years, including not requiring a second Planning Council public hearing. Additionally, if the County Commission approves the amendment, this action by the Planning Council shall serve as the "conditional" recertification of the municipal plan.
