- The Broward County Government Recycling Program provides recycling collection services and program support to county parks and government facilities.
- 110 government buildings and County parks participate in the Broward County Government Recycling Program.
- The Program develops recycling campaigns and educational materials to educate county employees on recycling best practices.
- Coordinates public outreach events and employee recycling related training.
- Conducts daily recycling assessments to ensure compliance and recommend service level adjustments for both recycling and waste based on field audits.
- 2,062,100 lbs. were recycled from Broward County government buildings and County parks in FY 23.
