# Snapshot Update #5 on June 12-14 Rain Event

The Broward County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains activated at Level 3 – Assessment and Monitoring. Due to localized flooding, Broward County remains under a <u>Local State of Emergency</u> and a Governor's <u>Declaration of Emergency</u> (Executive Order Number 24-115). The storm system is moving out of the area and no additional flooding is expected.

Friday morning Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, Florida Division of Emergency Management Director Kevin Guthrie and Florida Department of Transportation Director Jared Perdue, County Administrator Monica Cepero, and Clay Pacheco, the County's Emergency Management Director, briefed the state officials, and then Administrator Cepero participated in a tour of impacted areas in the southern part of the county.

### Here are the latest updates on Broward County's activities:

- Public Works: All County roads are clear. Highway and Bridge Maintenance Division teams
  are performing necessary roadway improvements. All Mosquito Control equipment is ready
  for deployment to minimize mosquito development. Mosquito Control Staff is performing
  surveillance activities and pre-treatment/larviciding activities in areas that have received a lot
  of rain.
- Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport is operational. All airport roadways are
  clear, and traffic is moving freely. Both FLL's runways are fully operational. The North Perry
  general aviation airport is operating normally.
- **Port Everglades** is open with no operational issues. *Disney Cruise Lines* and *Celebrity Cruises* arrived in port with no issues.
- Broward County Libraries are open with the exception of Lauderhill Central Park Library on Friday, June 14 and Saturday, June 15 for the T20 Cricket World Cup 2024 at the Central Broward Park and Broward County Stadium.
- **Broward County Landfill** has reopened for normal operations (8AM-4PM) to accept bulk waste and construction and demolition debris ONLY; no yard waste or tires at this time.
- Broward County Transit and Paratransit are running on normal schedules with the exception Route 6 (County Line Road and Dixie Highway to Broward Downtown Terminal). BCT Road Supervisors are in the area monitoring the status of this route detour. Paratransit services are operating normally (except in areas of localized flooding). Community Shuttle Services are running normal service except in Davie and Hallandale Beach. BCT will continue to support operations.

- Parks are open with the exception of three parks that are closed due to flooding: Easterlin,
  Hawksbill and Hollywood North Beach Park. Some amenities (horse trails, mountain bike and
  nature trails, and playgrounds) are closed. The ICC canceled today's USA VS IRELAND T20
  World Cup Match at Broward County Stadium in Central Broward Park.
- Animal Care resumed normal operations today.

\*SIDE NOTE: our Florida Panthers won Game 3 of the Championship Series last night, leading the series 3-0. One more to go on Saturday, June 15 in Edmonton to 'Bring it Home!' Go Cats!
