IT'S HOT FOR YOUR PETS, TOO!

Here are seven easy steps you can take to keep your fur babies cool during periods of warm weather.



DURING EXTREME HEAT

- Keep your pet hydrated by maintaining access to fresh, cool water
- Bring your pet inside or limit your pet's outdoor activity to cooler times of the day
- If outside, make sure your pet has access to comfortable shade
- Never leave your pet unattended in the car, it is illegal under Florida Law
- Keep paws off hot asphalt and pavement
- Trim hair, but do not shave your pet entirely to avoid sunburn
- Don't allow pets to overexert themselves in the heat
- Introduce rest breaks into play time to allow pets to cool down

KNOW THE SIGNS OF OVERHEATING

- Excessive panting and shortness of breath
- Excessive drooling
- Elevated body temperature over 104°F
- Increased pulse and respiratory rate
- Vomiting
- Discolored gums
